Tuition and Related Program Expenses

The apprenticeship programs at the Detroit Electrical Industry Training Center are funded by a joint labor-management partnership between the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 58 and the National Electrical Contractors Association of Southeastern Michigan.

Through this industry partnership and investment, the Detroit Electrical Industry Training Center offers comprehensive classroom and hands-on education for electrical apprentices at very little cost to the participant.

The following is an overview of the estimated related expenses for the Apprenticeship program:

Application Test Fee:	\$20.00 (due at time of test)
Physical Exam Fee:	\$52.00 (at time of physical)
Drug Testing Fee:	\$70.00 (upon passing entrance test and selection for program)
Tuition:	\$400.00 per year of program (3-5 years)
Basic Tools:	Up to \$250.00 based on program (onetime fee)
Books:	Up to \$400.00 based on the program (onetime fee)
Boots:	\$100-\$150 (based on personal preference, onetime purchase)
Work Apparel:	\$150-\$250 (based on personal preference, one time purchase)

The investment in additional tools, apparel or gear during the apprenticeship is at the discretion of the participant and is not a requirement of the program.
